



Dear Ms. Shilkoff:

Rosalie De Marco

November 9, 1932 - November 15, 2025 A loving mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, and adoring and devoted wife, Rosalie Doris (Hand) De Marco, 93, passed gently into God's arms in the early morning of November 15, 2025 in the presence of family and others who cared deeply for her. She leaves behind a legacy of love, service, loyalty, and a life lived with purpose and heart.

Born near downtown and raised in the Silverlake area of Los Angeles, Rosalie took on life's challenges and opportunities with a curiosity, drive, and engagement unequalled by many. She attended Elysian Heights Elementary School and Bishop Conaty High School, and graduated from Los Angeles City College where her meteorology studies led to a position with American Airlines' main ticket offices at the Hollywood Roosevelt Hotel and in downtown Los Angeles. It was across the street from the downtown location where she was introduced to Frank De Marco, Jr., who would become her adoring husband until his passing in 2022.

She devoted countless hours as a volunteer serving the Briarcliff neighborhood association, assisting in her children's classrooms, working the little league snack bar, and sharing her dedication to the natural world as a docent at the Los Angeles Zoo. She was always the first to offer her time and the last to seek recognition for it. Rosalie was a constant presence in her children's lives - driving carpools, attending nearly every game, equestrian event, artistic performance, and school function, showing her unwavering support of their community involvement. Her lifelong passion was her love of golden retrievers. A dedicated breeder, trainer and handler, she poured her heart into raising healthy, exceptional dogs. She proudly showed her goldens in competitions, earning multiple championships that reflected her expertise, patience, and deep connection to the breed. To her family, the dogs were more than companions - they were woven into the fabric of home life, with each child growing up alongside countless litters of adorable puppies, and a golden of their own.

She played tennis weekly with close friends, had a crossword puzzle always in progress, and created graceful homes through her joy of interior decoration and landscape design. Summers spent in Del Mar were among her happiest times; the beach was her sanctuary, a place she returned to year after year for peace, connection, and renewal.

Deeply loyal to her friends, Rosalie nurtured lifelong relationships marked by honesty, humor, and steadfast devotion. She loved her family with a fierce commitment. She spoke her mind, stood by her values, and cared deeply for those who were blessed to be part of her life.

Rosalie was preceded in death by her beloved husband of 64 years, Frank De Marco, Jr., by her parents Herman and Doris (Westphal) Hand; and by her sister, Shirley Rhoads. She is survived by her children, John (Elena), Thomas (Leslie), Maria Ramsey (Daren Ramsey), Peter, and Michael; by her grandchildren, Stephanie DeMarco (Michael Albanese), Gregory, Robert, Andrew, Helena DeMarco (Jakob Murray), Sophia June and Christopher June; by her great-grand daughter, Isla Murray; and by her five nieces.






